Environmental Self-Assessment Scheme & Environmental Improvement Audit

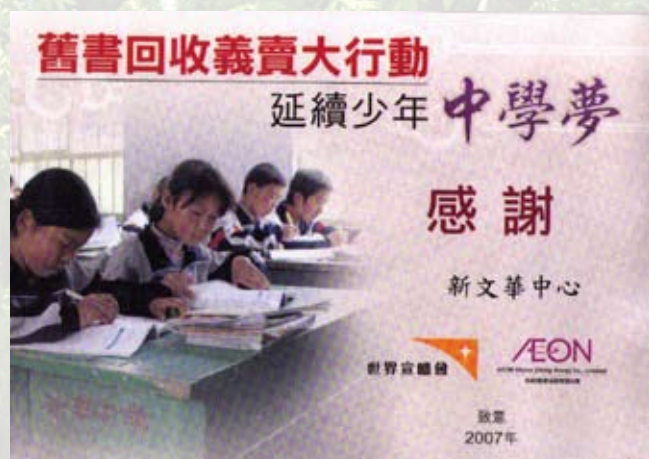
Environmental Self-Assessment Scheme was carried out in all our managed buildings in July and August 2007 to awake our staff awareness in environmental protection in our daily operation. A environmental checklist was distributed to all buildings and the Building-In-Charge could easily assess the extend of green participation in their managed buildings by reference to a self-assessment checklist. Environmental Improvement Audits were conducted by members of Environmental Working Group in November and December 2007 in part of our managed properties and Environmental Improvement Report had been prepared.
